

# MADISON COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL RULES - 2007

## Madison County Commissioners Court has approved the following set of rules for Solid Waste Disposal in Madison County.

1. All persons using the Solid Waste Transfer Stations must purchase a permit from the Tax Assessor/Collector's office located in the Courthouse. There are no exceptions. Permits are required beginning January 5, 2007.
2. Only one Solid Waste Disposal sticker per household is provided for the fee of \$50.00 per year. The sticker should be placed on the windshield near the rear-view mirror facing outward.
3. Only residents of Madison County will be permitted to purchase a permit and use the transfer facility. No out of county residents will be permitted to use the facilities.
4. Bagged household garbage tied at the top will be accepted at the transfer stations. Feed sack, flour sacks and garbage bags will be accepted, if tied at the top. Cardboard boxes will be accepted only if flattened and tied flat.
5. Used oil will be accepted at Precinct 1, 2 and 4 transfer stations in the designated containers.
6. Tires will be accepted at Precinct #1 for a disposal fee of \$2.00 for car and light truck tires, \$5.00 for large truck tires and \$10.00 for farm implement tires. No commercial tires will be accepted.
7. Appliances currently or previously containing freon, including refrigerators, freezers and window air conditioning units, will be accepted at Precinct #2 and Precinct #4 for a disposal fee of \$10.00.
8. Appliances not containing freon, including dishwashers, washers and dryers, will be accepted at Precinct #2 and Precinct #4 for a disposal fee of \$5.00.
9. Other metal items, including scrap metal, excluding any type wire, will be accepted at Precinct #2 and Precinct #4 free of charge with a current Solid Waste Disposal permit.
10. Other furniture items, including mattresses, box springs, wood products & burnable items, will be accepted at Precinct #4 free of charge with a current disposal permit.
11. Plastics, such as outside play toys or containers, computers, monitors, microwaves, televisions or comparable appliances will not be accepted at any transfer station location.
12. Receipts will be issued to residents for their disposal fees.
13. Privately owned trash collecting services or any private businesses WILL NOT BE permitted to use the transfer stations for disposal.
14. Non-compliance with the Madison County Solid Waste procedures could result in prosecution under the Texas Litter Laws.
