ORDER LEVYING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2011

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Madison County, Texas convened in regular session on Monday, September 26, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. in the County Court Room, Madison County Courthouse Madisonville, Texas.

WHEREAS, the Court, having first adopted its budget for fiscal year 2011-2012, now desires to establish a property tax rate to support the 2011-2012 budget;

NOW THEREFORE, on the following motion "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.6000/100 evaluation which is effectively a 10.37527% percent increase in the tax rate" made, seconded and adopted by the vote indicated here below, the Commissioners Court of Madison County, Texas hereby orders that ad valorem taxes on property located in Madison County for the year 2011 shall be levied and collected from property owners at the following rates, based on each One Hundred Dollars(\$100) of assessed valuation:

0.6000 For Maintenance and Operations  
0.6000 Total Tax Rate

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TOTAL PROPERTY TAXES THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 0.0564 AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$56.40.
