

DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, Madison County has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from weather events including rain, wind, and /or flooding which has occurred since October 13, 2018; and


WHEREAS, the County Judge and Commissioners Court of Madison County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF MADISON COUNTY




1. That a local state of disaster was initially declared for Madison County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code on October 16, 2018. Said state of disaster began October 13, 2018.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than thirty days from October 23, 2018.
3. Pursuant to § 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster continues the activation of the county emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance and shall be related to activities that have occurred and will occur in conjunction with the event described above.

Commissioners Court has officially extended the disaster declaration for Madison County for 30 days from October 23, 2018.
